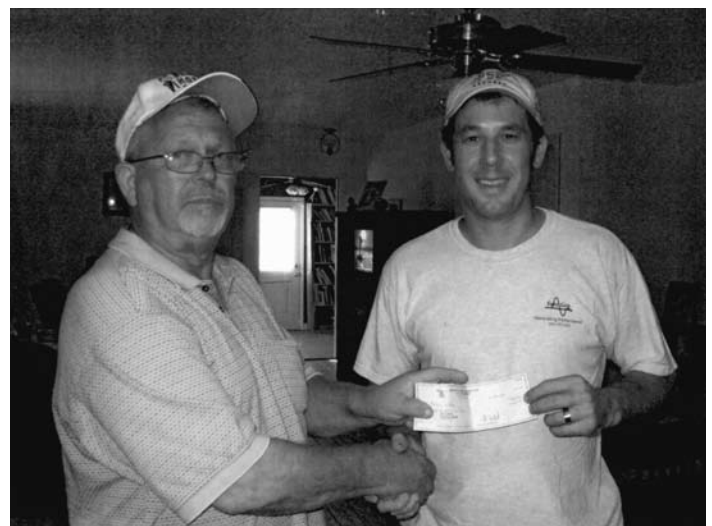
WHEREAS, Sudan Shriners' dues have not increased since 1999; and
