Our membership totals continue dropping. Last year our net loss in membership was 154. We created 147 new members and had 183 deaths. Our membership as of 31 December 2009 was 6025.

Last year saw two new temples created under dispensation, one in the Philippines and the other in Puerto Rico. there is even more interest in other locations, such as, Central and South America and Europe. 




