## Recorder's Message

Well, here we are in our last quarter of 2010. Much has happened in the Shrine this year. Two new temples, Al Rai'e Saleh Shriners in San Juan, Puerto Rico and Mabuhay Shriners in Manila, Philippines and Emirat Shriners in Germany were granted dispensation to form. Additional interest among Master Masons to become Shriners continues in other parts of the world and I expect we will continue seeing new temples in the future.

Sudan's annual Cold Sands Ceremonial on 11 September 2010 created 27 new members and accepted one new Affiliate member. Please look over a list of these new Nobles elsewhere in this issue of the Red Fez Magazine and welcome them into our Shrine family.

The Fall Ceremonial in Dunn is fast approaching. Come enjoy the festivities and bring a candidate. The Dunn Shrine Club nobility and their ladies are working hard to provide a fun-filled weekend. As you know, Dunn always organizes a fine ceremonial.

You may have heard unfounded and untrue rumors about the temple building. One rumor has it that the temple will be sold and moved. There are no such plans. Let's set straight just what is going on with the temple building. Early this year we discovered building problems. Our unique structure has some years of use as the major portion of the temple was completed in 1951 and the office/dormitory section added in 1956. Years of wear and tear and neglect have taken a toll. Water leaks have caused damage; windows need repair and/or replacement; new carpet is needed in the office; cement block walls may be leaking water; there is some wood rot; plumbing needs repair; cosmetic upgrades are needed such a paint; the auditorium floor needs attention.

During the May 2010 Board of Directors Meeting Illustrious Sir Mike Farrell appointed a "Temple Building Investigating & Advisory Committee" chaired by High Priest & Prophet Ken Bennett. Noble Bennett and his committee have spent numerous hours identifying various building problems and generated a prioritized list of what needs attention along with cost estimates. Noble Bennett gave his report on this issue during the 11 September 2010 Stated Meeting and the membership voted to proceed with the committee's recommendations for repairing the temple. This won't happen overnight. There is a lot of work ahead of us. The most urgent is an expensive roof repair which began on 13 September 2010. The roof leaks must be addressed before other repairs, some major and some minor can be done.

The South Atlantic Shrine Association in Myrtle Beach, S.C. was well attended by Sudan. Our units won "Best Overall Temple" and our units were awarded 15 plaques. WELL DONE!

Other news from Imperial may be of interest to you. In 2009 Imperial formed a "Revenue Cycle Committee" whose purpose is to find ways to offset an approximate \$175 million plus shortfall needed to operate Shriners Hospitals for Children. You may recall that during the 2009 Imperial Session it was decided to create an operation to accept third party pay from patients who have medical insurance coverage, if the patients' parents wish to allow their insurance to pay whatever it will pay. There will be no demand for them to pay, just an option if they wish. Imperial Chief Rabban Al Madsen of Oasis Shriners is the committee chairman and tremendous work has been and is being done with this matter. On 17 June 2010 the first invoice was mailed for medical care. This new system of third party pay is expected to substantially help with revenue shortfalls.

Enough for now – see you at the Fall Ceremonial in Dunn, on 19 & 20 November.

## Honor Flight to DC

The doors at Wilmington International Airport opened to the sounds of the Glenn Miller Orchestra and war stories Wednesday morning. Among the red, white and blue decorations, 102 World War II veterans chatted as they waited to board an Honor Flight to Washington, D.C.

Each of these men and women who served in the United States military during the war was supplied with a free airplane ticket to view the World War II Memorial on the National Lawn. They received free meals, courtesy medics and wheelchairs during their visit, and a hero's welcome back to Wilmington in time for supper.

It was all paid for by Honor Flight Southeastern North Carolina, the local chapter of the Honor Flight Network, a nonprofit organization dedicated to giving veterans, especially those who served during World War II, the opportunity to see national memorials dedicated to them.

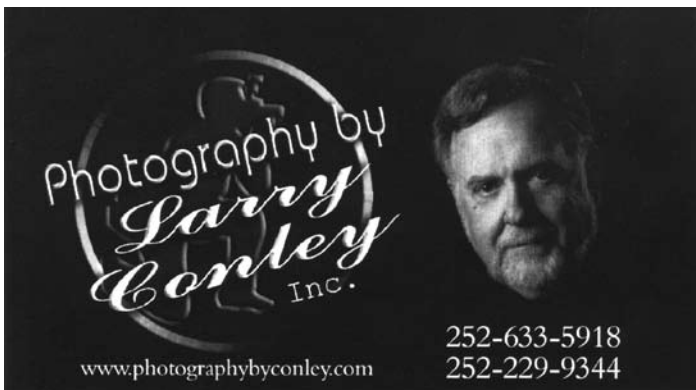
When they stepped off the plane and onto the concourse, they were surprised by several Marines in dress blues and two airmen who shook the veterans' hands, personally welcomed them to Washington, D.C., and thanked them for their service to the country.

Three tour buses took the veterans and 33 volunteers called "guardians" to the World War II Memorial. Some had to use wheelchairs and walkers to tour the sprawling granite and bronze memorial site. The memorial, which was dedicated on May 29, 2004, honors 16 million men and women who served in uniform during World War II. It also honors millions others who supported them and the war effort in the United States families, steelworkers and farmers.

Without this free flight and the many volunteers who donated their time and money to the effort, some of these veterans never would have been able to see it. All of the veterans were in their late 80s or older.

Their chartered plane landed back in Wilmington about 7:30 p.m. to music, military color guards and a large flag-waving and cheering crowd.

Those attending from Sudan were: Louis Smith, Jr., Charlie O. Smith and Richard Gough (not pictured). They were greeted by the Drum & Bugle Corps.

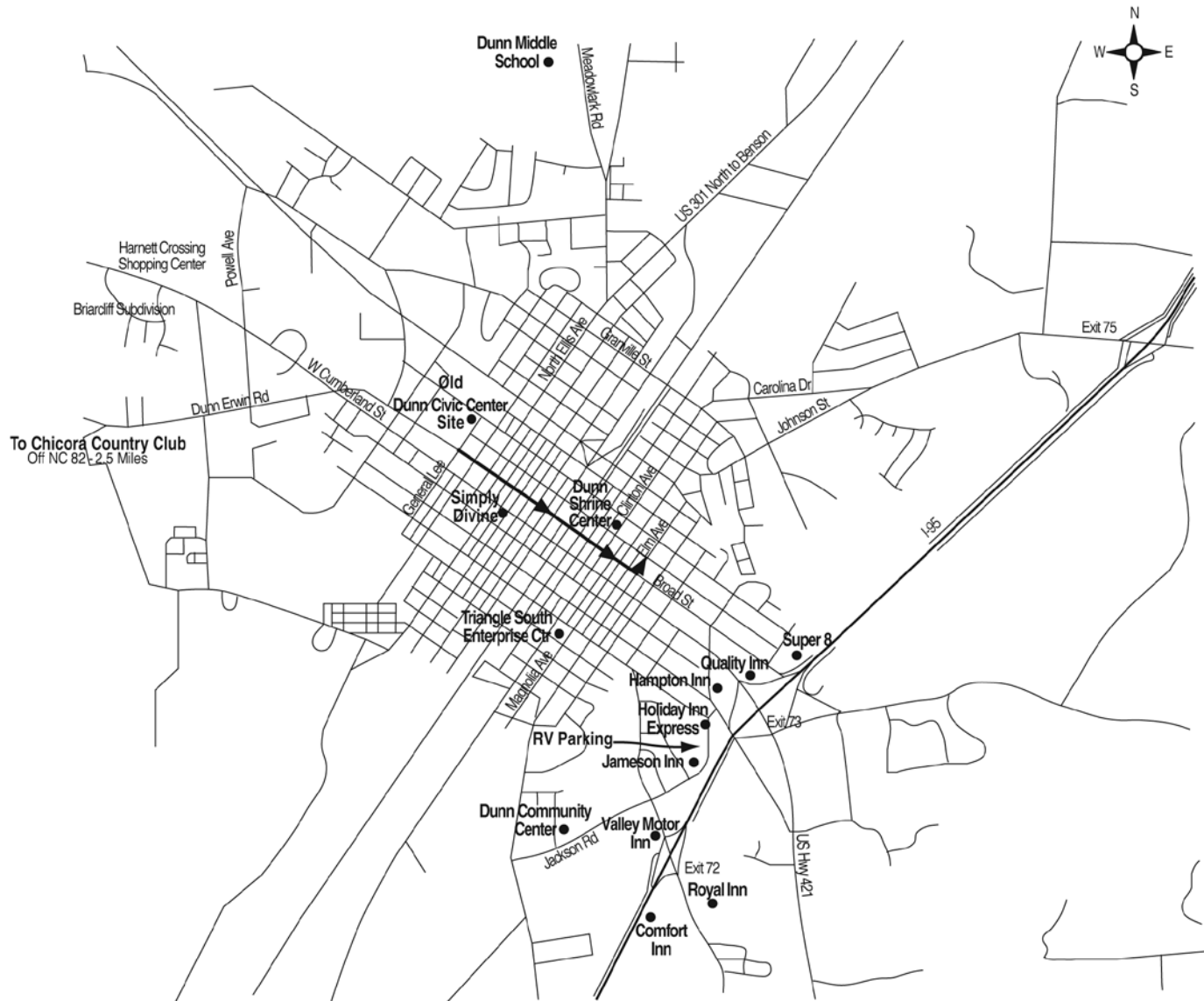

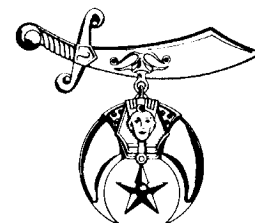

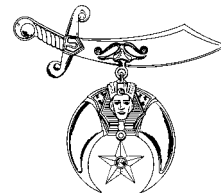
